

EXHIBIT B
IFC Recruitment REGULATIONS

Section 1 - No recruitment activities are to occur outside the period of formal recruitment.

Section 2 - Recruitment events outside of 120 miles from Charlottesville are subject to review by the IFC Recruitment Chair

Section 3 - No alcohol is to be present during any recruitment function; this includes Bid Day.

Section 4 - Fraternities may not sponsor Tier 1 social functions during the recruitment period, as outlined in the Fraternal Organization Agreement.

Section 5 - During No Contact days, no contact may take place between potential new members and fraternity members.

Section 6 - During Open House, 60% of the fraternity must be present throughout the duration of the event.

Section 7 - During Final Hours, no contact may take place between potential new members and fraternity members except during designated Final Hours times.

Section 8 - Fraternities are prohibited from interfering with the ability of potential new members to participate in other fraternities' recruitment events.

Section 9 - Bid Day Procedure:

- (a) On Bid Day, no bids shall be extended except during times designated by the University and the Inter-Fraternity Council.
- (b) A fraternity shall not allow men who are given bids to physically join that fraternity during the designated times for all fraternities to extend bids.
- (c) A fraternity shall not distract nor coerce potential new members who are traveling to accept bids from other fraternities.
- (d) Events held on Bid Day/Night are considered formal recruitment events
